



# COMBO Discount - **HOW TO**

## Introduction

The new combo discount feature in Menumate 5.17.1.0 allows you to COMBO a number of items in a sale to a set price.

### To Setup Combo Discount

- Press **Maintenance**
- **Discount and Surcharges** and log in

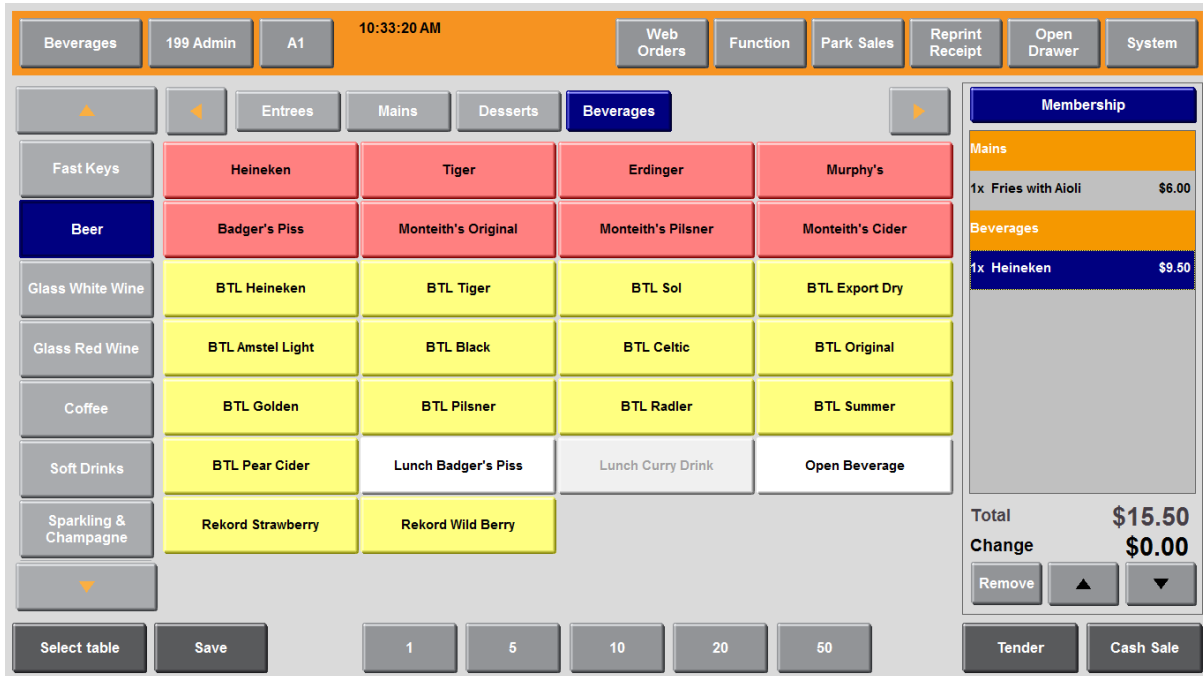

Setting up a Combo Discount is the same as all other discounts with two differences.

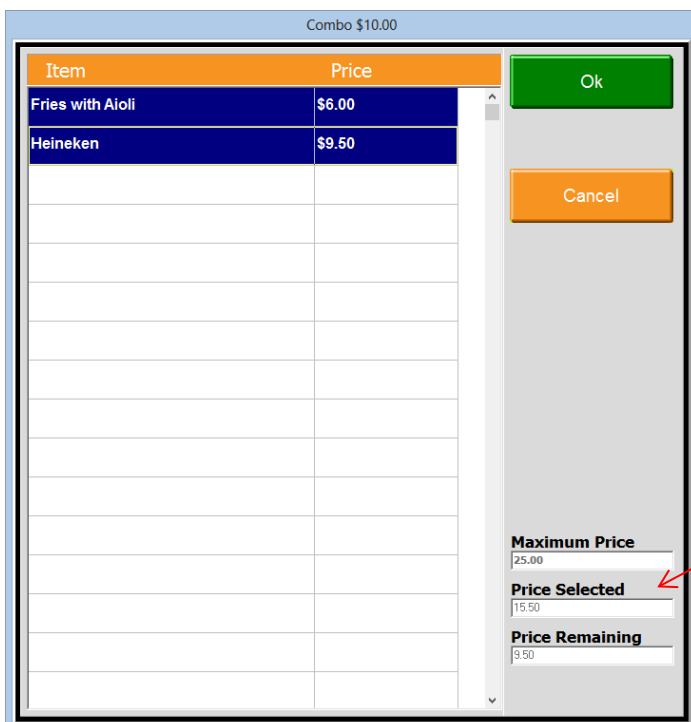
1. The discount type needs to be set to COMBO
2. You need to set a maximum value so that the operator does not discount 50.00 of items down to a 10.00 combo

### To Use Combo Discount

The example below has a combo promotion running for any beer and fries for \$10.00. The operator has sold the items (note: they can sell more items and apply the combo order multiple combos at the end of the sale)



The operator would press FUNCTION and COMBO and select the combo that they are applying. In this case the \$10.00 combo. The operator can then select the items from the sale that they are applying the combo to.



The combo screen will show the total amount applied as well as the Maximum price they can use and the balance available still to apply.

The items will then be discounted DOWN to the combo price.
